On the 22nd–23rd of August 2013, meeting of Ukrainian Pancreatic Club took place in the town Yurevka (Donetsk region). It was attended by the Club members from most regions of Ukraine.

Meeting was opened by the President's of the Club Prof. N. B. Gubergrits (Donetsk) report on the news of European pancreatology based on the meeting of European Pancreatic Club (Zurich, June 2013).

The next speaker was Prof. V. N. Klimenko (Zaporozhye) with a report on the medical and surgical problems of treatment of chronic pancreatitis and their solutions.

Prof. N. B. Gubergrits described the pathogenetic significance of bacterial overgrowth syndrome upon chronic pancreatitis.

Report by I. G. Paly (Vinnitsa) had to do with a safety of PPIs in clinical practice, including pancreatology.

Prof. N. B. Gubergrits reported on the pathogenesis, diagnostics, and treatment of chronic alcoholic pancreatitis.

Report by Prof. A. E. Dorofeev (Donetsk) was devoted to the pathogenesis and treatment of pancreatitis in patients with ulcerative colitis.

Prof. V. N. Chernobrov (Vinnitsa) described the mechanisms of formation of associated diseases: liver cirrhosis and chronic pancreatitis, problems of diagnostics and treatment. Another speaker from Vinnitsa associate professor S. G. Melashchenko reported on the results of his study on assessing the dynamics of serum pepsinogens in gastroenterological patients upon receiving PPIs.

Prof. G. A. Anokhina (Kiev) presented information on new spasmolytic, which will soon enter the practice of gastroenterologists.

The first day of meeting was ended by the report of Prof. N. B. Gubergrits on the effectiveness of pantoprazole upon chronic pancreatitis and on the new reparant Doktovit (complex of vitamins B₅ and U).

The second day began with a clinical case of patient with severe trophological insufficiency. Patient was presented by associate professor O. A. Golubova (Donetsk). Traditional "duel" was going on between Prof. A. D. Zubov (Donetsk) and Prof. N. B. Gubergrits. As always, the participants came to the most probable diagnosis and drew tactics of treatment as a result of case.

Associate professor O. V. Shvets (Kiev) told about state of nutrition of patient with chronic pancreatitis and the possibility of its correction.

Joint report by Prof. A. D. Zubov and Prof. N. B. Gubergrits "Labyrinths of pancreatology" was devoted to pseudotumor-like pancreatitis.

Prof. T. N. Khristich (Chernovtsy) reported on the significance of certain pancreatic gastrointestinal peptides upon obesity.

Associate professor O. V. Shvets told about the link between diet, intestinal microflora and gastroenterological diseases.

Meeting was ended up with report by associate professor O. A. Golubova on the effect of caffeine on various organs and systems and the report by Prof. N. B. Gubergrits on the new herbal preparation, which is included into the gastroenterological practice.
